Dear Applicant(s) / Owner(s):

On January 27, 2015, the Mobile Tree Commission considered your request for City of Mobile to remove three (3), 36"± dbh Water Oak trees from City property (one in the Wildwood Avenue right-of-way, and two on city owned property).

After discussion, the request to remove the tree in the right of way was denied. The Tree Commission also recommended the following:

- 1. the applicant coordinate all work in the right-of-way and on the private property with Urban Forestry to ensure a little damage as possible is done to the tree(s);
- 2. Urban Forestry to coordinate selective pruning and compaction for the other two trees on private property with applicant's contractor;
- 3. Urban Forestry is to ask the Engineering Department to help determine the property line to determine ownership of the two trees;
- 4. Any decision regarding removal of the two trees on private property, and associated expense, will be the responsibility of the owner of the trees based on determination of the property line location; and
- 5. The applicant should also be advised that any and all work within the right-of-way will require a right-of-way permit from the Engineering Department of the City of Mobile.
