Dear Applicant(s) / Property Owner(s):

On August 18, 2015, the Mobile Tree Commission considered your request to remove a Water Oak.

After discussion, the Mobile Tree Commission approved your request for at the above referenced location, subject to the following:

- 1. All work, including grinding of the stump, to done by Urban Forestry and Alabama Power (around the power lines);
- 2. One replacement tree, such as a Crepe Myrtle, to be planted by the applicant;
- 3. All work to be coordinated with Forestry; and
- 4. A right-of-way permit is required for restoration of the right-of-way, including the sidewalk and driveway, which is to be undertaken at the applicant's expense.

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Mobile City Council by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed with the Mobile City Council must be filed with the Mobile Tree Commission within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. For additional assistance call (251) 208-5895.
