- 1. Obtaining of permit for any required work in the Right-of-Way from Right-of-Way Permitting Division;
- 2. Work to be coordinated with the appropriate utility provider(s); and
- 3. Provision of replacement trees, to be coordinated with Urban Forestry; or
- 4. Donation of trees to the Mobile Tree Commission tree bank, at a cost of \$200.00 per tree.



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
