<u>COMMENTS</u> Urban Forestry recommends denial of the permit to remove the Bradford Pear Trees because of sign blockage and the view of the building being limited. The trees are average Bradford Pears, with a plethora of weak branch attachments. The canopy can be trimmed to help with some of the concerns.

### **PLANNING**

**COMMENTS** Based on aerial photos, it appears that the building was constructed between 1984 and 1997. Some of the trees appear to be there in the 1997 aerial photo, and all are definitely in the 2002 aerials. This raises the question as to whether the trees were required at the time of construction or as a result of some other activity.

**ANALYSIS** The applicant is requesting permission to remove five Bradford Pear trees that are located in the right-of-way. The application states that the reason for the request as "Unsightly, blocks view of building + sign".

It has been the policy and practice of the Tree Commission to not approve requests when the main reason is to improve visibility of a sign or building. While Bradford Pear is not a desired or preferred species, they are the only trees at this location. If they are approved for removal, there will not be any trees in the immediate area, with the exception of some Crepe Myrtles and Bradford Pears in front of the property adjacent to the West. Such an approval could open the door for the neighboring property owner to make a similar request.

Further, Forestry Comments indicate that trimming the trees will address some of the issues.

**RECOMMENDATION** Based on the preceding, this request is recommended for denial, and that the applicant be advised to call 311 and request that the trees be trimmed.






