Dear Applicant(s) / Property Owner(s):

On September 15, 2015, the Mobile Tree Commission approved the above request, subject to the following:

1. All work, including grinding of the stump, is to be done by a licensed arborist, at the applicant's expense;
2. All work is to be coordinated with Forestry,
3. One replacement tree, such as a Crepe Myrtle, to be planted by the applicant; and
4. A right-of-way permits is required for all work in the right-of-way, including restoration of the neutral ground after the stump has been ground.

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Mobile City Council by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed with the Mobile City Council must be filed with the Mobile Tree Commission within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. After the appeal period has expired and there are no appeals, the permit must be obtained from the City of Mobile Planning and Zoning office prior to commencement of work.
