COMMENTS The site driveway in general is consistent with the 2008 plan, and follows our recommendation to only allow a single right-in, right-out driveway for both sites (the proposed site and a future development on the corner lot). The location of the driveway is best located at or near the dividing property line, at a point between the signalized intersection to the west and the median opening to the east. The driveway might could be shifted to the west to avoid Tree #2, but then would be further impacting the critical root zone of Tree #1.

Tree trimming for Tree #1 is appropriate for the need to improve line of sight for vehicles exiting the driveway. Tree trimming for Tree #4 and Tree #5 is questionable based on driveway safety, since the driveway is right out only, and does not specifically require a line of sight to the east.

URBAN FORESTRY

<u>COMMENTS</u> The driveway will be 4'± from the tree to be removed, which does necessitate removal of the tree. The tree is healthy, therefore, according to policy, must be replaced with two trees. Given the number of trees currently in the Dauphin Street right-of-way, planting of the replacement trees in that area is not practical. Since plans for the remaining lots have not yet been developed, it would be ill advised to have them planted along Sage Avenue. The applicant has been advised that a donation to the tree bank for these trees may be required.

PLANNING

COMMENTS There is a pending Planned Unit Development application before the Planning Commission that will be considered on October 20th. One of the reasons for that application is to allow the curb cut as proposed. Based on the overall site for the PUD, the location of the driveway as proposed has been reviewed by all relevant city departments and determined to be the most appropriate location.

Given this determination, it is likely that the PUD will be approved.

ANALYSIS As stated above, the applicant is requesting approval for the removal of one live oak and permission to trim two others. The reason is the location of a new driveway to Dauphin Street falls within 4' of the tree to be removed, and the trimming is to improve line of sight for vehicles entering and existing the site.

Not only is the proposed location of the drive the most advantageous for this particular property, but also for the PUD as a whole. In addition, the applicant has indicated that the trees were considered in the site layout and the proposed location negatively impacted only one tree as opposed to shifting it in either direction (east or west) would have caused it to then impact two trees. Therefore, the location as proposed was chosen.

The applicant has been made aware of the policy of a two for one replacement when healthy trees are removed. As stated above, a donation to the tree bank would be more appropriate for this site than an actual replanting in the immediate vicinity.

Given the pending PUD application, if the removal is approved, the approval should be contingent upon approval of the PUD by the Planning Commission, with no work to occur in the interim. As for the trimming request, Forestry has indicated that the trees in question need to be cleaned and trimmed up, and that if timing allows Forestry may be able to perform the trimming under an SRO. However, if timing does not work, the applicant would like the ability to hire someone to trim the trees.

RECOMMENDATION Based on the preceding, the request for the removal on one Live Oak is recommended for APPROVAL, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Approval of the PUD by the Planning Commission;
- 2. No work to occur until after the PUD has been approved and the appeal period has expired;
- 3. Donation of two trees to the tree bank;
- 4. All work is to be coordinated with Urban Forestry, and if necessary APCO; and
- 5. All work in the right-of-way requires a right-of-way permit.

It is further recommended that the trimming of two Live Oaks be approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Approval of the PUD by the Planning Commission;
- 2. No work to occur until after the PUD has been approved and the appeal period has expired;
- 3. If the trees are not trimmed by Urban Forestry, all work must be done by a licensed and bonded arborist, and coordinated with Urban Forestry;
- 4. All work in the right-of-way requires a right-of-way permit.


