The applicant is redeveloping and renovating portions of the Pinebrook Shopping Center, located on Airport Boulevard at McGregor Avenue. As part of the project the applicant obtained Planned Unit Development from the Mobile City Palning Commission (along with several other approvals). One component of the PUD approval was an new landscaping plan along Airport Boulevard. While the Planning Commission approved that plan, it was also noted that permits from the Mobile Tree Commission would be required to remove any trees located in the right of way.

The approved landscape plan calls for the planting of 15 live oaks on the private property, along the Airport Boulevard frontage, adjacent to the property line. In addition, there are 12 crepe myrtles and 9 cabbage palms to be planted in the front of the site between Airport Boulevard and the parking lot.

The proposed plantings in front and throughout the site will be a significant improvement and increase over the existing plantings.

ANALYSIS The applicant's proposed landscape plan represents a significant increase in the number of trees, with a preferred species (live oak) along the Airport Boulevard frontage. The overall planting plan represents a cohesive landscape plan and will substantially improve the streetscape.

The only concern would be what is to happen with the eight crepe myrtle trees that are to be removed? Since they are healthy, relocation would be preferable over simply cutting them down and removing the stumps.

RECOMMENDATION Based on the preceding, it is recommended that the request be approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The eight trees removed be donated to the Tree Commission for planting elsewhere in the City;
- 2. Adherence to the approved landscape plan; and
- 3. All removal work to be performed by a licensed arborist, and at the applicant's expense.
