LOCATION: 3258 Stein Street

Reason for request is to remove 2 Water Oak Trees, 1 Popcorn Tree, and 1 Camphor Tree.

TREE HEALTH: Two Water Oak Trees, one Popcorn Tree, and one Camphor Tree, all of which are healthy.

<u>SITUATION</u>: Citizen would like to remove all of the trees. They are all under existing power lines and a poor species for this location. The trees will never be able to develop to maturity.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends removal of all four trees with the following conditions:

- 1. All work done at owner's expense;
- 2. Replacement of 1/1 with an acceptable species for this location, for example, Live Oak or Crape Myrtle Trees;
- 3. Location and species to be coordinated with Urban Forestry;
- 4. Right of Way permit required prior to planting.
