

Sidewalk – Hillcrest Road Widening Project ALDOT (Cottage Hill Road to Windsor Drive)

Ron, ALDOT is about to transfer maintenance responsibility for Hillcrest Road to the City. There is a section of sidewalk on the west side, south of the AHEEPA Apartments, that was constructed by ALDOT very close to the curb and with a steep cross section relative to the curb. We feel that this could present a liability to the City. When the permit for the project was submitted to the Tree Commission, the existing tree that was left in place apparently was not permitted for removal. This forced ALDOT to locate the walk close to the curb.

Please meet with Janic and determine what needs to be involved with removing this tree. This will enable the City to install a new walk, to eliminate a potential hazard.

LOCATION: 2550 Hillcrest Road

TREE HEALTH: Trees are in good health.

<u>SITUATION</u>: Engineering Department is requesting the removal of 14" Magnolia and 4"double trunk Dogwood trees in order to lower the sidewalk down to street elevation. Lowering the sidewalk will reduce the chance of someone falling into the street.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the removal of the two trees to correct the problem of the sidewalk elevation.
