

TREE HEALTH: Damaged during recent storm.

SITUATION: Kings Mill subdivision is requesting to remove the last remaining Bradford Pear Tree in order to plant new Crape Myrtle Trees. The new Crape Myrtle Trees will replace the storm damaged Bradford Pear Trees along Knollwood Drive.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval to the removal of the Bradford Pear Tree with the condition that the new trees are planted with an approved right-of-way permit.
