<u>SITUATION</u>: Kings Mill subdivision is requesting to remove the last remaining Bradford Pear Tree in order to plant new Crape Myrtle Trees. The new Crape Myrtle Trees will replace the storm damaged Bradford Pear Trees along Knollwood Drive.
