

TREE HEALTH: The Popcorn trees are in good health.

SITUATION: Applicant states the tree next to driveway is vision problem. Traffic Engineering reports the tree is not a line of sight. A sidewalk repair SRO has been made to repair broken sidewalk. The tree in the middle of the yard is reported to be causing problems with the water meter. There is evidence of root pruning to repair the meter, but no documentation has been submitted with the application of repairs made to the meter.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends removal of trees due to species type.
