(Case #BOA-001336-2020) Furr Street Partners, LLC

108 and 110 Furr Street

(East side of Furr Street, 185'± North of Old Shell Road).

**Parking and Maneuvering Surface Variance to allow aggregate surfacing in a B-3, Community Business District; the Zoning Ordinance requires parking and maneuvering surfaces to be paved with concrete, asphalt, asphaltic concrete, or an approved alternative paving surface in a B-3, Community Business District.** Council District 1 Motion to approve by Lewis Golden. Second by Adam Metcalfe. Approved.

2. #6367

(Case #BOA-001462-2020) <u>Debbie and Tommy Hartley</u> 2100 North University Boulevard (East side of North University Boulevard at the East terminus of Mickey Drive). Use Variance to allow a special events center in an R-1, Single-Family Residential District; the Zoning Ordinance requires at least a B-2, Neighborhood Business District, for a special events center. Council District 1

Withdrawn at meeting by the applicants.

After discussion with the Board, the applicants withdrew the request.

3. #6368

(Case #BOA-001468-2020) Janael Moguel 1409 Greenbrier Drive (East side of Greenbrier Drive, 270'± South of Halls Mill Road). Use Variance to allow a maximum of twelve (12) children in a home-based child day care business in an R-1, Single-Family Residential District; the Zoning Ordinance does not allow more than six (6) children in a home-based child day care business in an R-1, Single-Family Residential District. Council District 4

Motion to approve by Vernon Coleman. Second by Sanford Davis. Approved.

#### After discussion, the Board determined the following Findings of Fact for Approval:

- 1) Approving the variance will not be contrary to the public interest;
- 2) Special conditions were illustrated such that a literal enforcement of the provisions of the chapter will result in an unnecessary hardship; and
- 3) The spirit of the chapter shall be observed, and substantial justice shall be done to the surrounding neighborhood by granting the variance.

#### The approval is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Compliance with all requirements of the Alabama Department of Human Resources for daycare facilities with 12 children;
- 2. Compliance with all Fire requirements for daycare facilities with 12 children; and
- 3. Full compliance with all other municipal codes and ordinances.
