Dear Applicant(s) / Property Owner(s):

On December 3, 2012, the Board of Zoning Adjustment approved your extension request for Use, Parking Ratio, and Multiple Building Variances to allow an 800 square foot take-out restaurant with an existing detached storage building with two parking spaces in an R-3, Multiple-Family Residential District at the above referenced location.

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. If a permit/license has not been obtained on or before June 3, 2013, the **Use, Parking Ratio, and Multiple Building Variances** will expire and become null and void.
