Dear Applicant(s) / Property Owner(s):

On May 6, 2013, the Board of Zoning Adjustment approved your request for Use Variance to allow two horses on residential property in an R-1, Single-Family Residential District at the above referenced location, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) that the use be limited to one full sized horse and one miniature horse; and
- 2) full compliance with all other municipal codes and ordinances.

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. If a permit/license has not been obtained on or before November 6, 2013, the **Use Variance** will expire and become null and void. For additional assistance call (251) 208-5895.
