Surfacing, Tree Planting and Screening Variances to allow a contractor's storage yard in an I-1, Light-Industry District, (rezoning pending) with a partially open vegetative buffer, aggregate parking surface and no tree planting; the Zoning Ordinance requires the storage area to be completely enclosed with an 8' high wall or privacy fence, the equipment parking area to be paved in asphalt, concrete, or an approved alternative paving surface, and full compliance with tree plantings.

Dear Applicant(s)/Property Owner(s):

On August 6, 2012, the Board of Zoning Adjustment heard your request for Surfacing, Tree Planting and Screening Variances to allow a contractor's storage yard in an I-1, Light-Industry District, (rezoning pending) with a partially open vegetative buffer, aggregate parking surface and no tree planting; the Zoning Ordinance requires the storage area to be completely enclosed with an 8' high wall or privacy fence, the equipment parking area to be paved in asphalt, concrete, or an approved alternative paving surface, and full compliance with tree plantings, at the above referenced location.

After discussion, the Board decided to hold the matter over until the September 10, 2012, meeting to allow the applicant to revise the site plan to incorporate any pertinent conditions of approval of the subdivision and rezoning, if both should be approved at the Planning Commission's August meeting.
