On December 1, 2008, the Board approved your request for Use, Access, Landscaping and Tree Planting Variances to allow a specialty gift shop in a B-1, Buffer Business District with 10' wide one-way access drives at the above referenced location, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) coordination of necessary landscaping and tree planting with the Planning Staff of the city's Urban Development department; and,
- 2) limiting the gift shop use to that of the area of the previous on-site gift shop.

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. If a permit/license has not been obtained on or before June 1, 2009, the **Use, Access, Landscaping and Tree Planting Variances** will expire and become null and void.
