Dear Applicant/Property Owner:

On June 4, 2012, the Board of Zoning Adjustment considered a variance to allow a total of five wall signs for a tenant with two street frontages on a group business site in a B-2, Neighborhood Business District.

After discussion, the Board approved four non-illuminated canopy signs (two along Airport Boulevard, one along Old Government Street and one at the corner of Airport Boulevard and Old Government Street).

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. If a permit/license has not been obtained on or before December 4, 2012, the **Sign Variance** will expire and become null and void. For additional assistance call (251) 208-5895.
