Sign Variance to amend a previously approved Sign Variance to allow two additional wall signs at 443 square feet each and a 1,095 square-foot wall sign, for a new total of 7,647 square feet of signage in an I-2, Heavy Industry District; the Zoning Ordinance limits wall signs to 30% of the usable wall area up to a maximum of 350 square feet per sign for a single-tenant site in an I-2, Heavy Industry District.

Dear Applicant/Property Owner:

On January 9, 2012, the Board of Zoning Adjustment approved a variance to amend a previously approved Sign Variance to allow two additional wall signs at 443 square feet each and a 1,095 square-foot wall sign, for a new total of 7,647 square feet of signage in an I-2, Heavy Industry District, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) the obtaining of a sign permit for each sign; and
- 2) compliance with all other municipal codes and ordinances.

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. If a permit/license has not been obtained on or
