**Parking Surface Variance to amend a previously approved Surfacing, Off-Site Parking, and Access/Maneuvering Variance to allow three additional gravel-surfaced parking spaces in a B-5, Office-Distribution District; the Zoning Ordinance requires parking surfaces to be paved with asphalt, concrete, or an approved alternative paving surface in a B-5, Office-Distribution District.**

Dear Applicant(s) / Property Owner(s):

On November 5, 2012, the Board of Zoning Adjustment approved your request for **Parking Surface Variance to amend a previously approved Surfacing, Off-Site Parking, and Access/Maneuvering Variance to allow three additional gravel-surfaced parking spaces in a B-5, Office-Distribution District** at the above referenced location, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) compliance with all other municipal codes and ordinances.**

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.


No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made.
