Dear Applicant/Property Owner:

On May 2, 2011, the Board of Zoning Adjustment approved a variance to allow a residential care facility for youth between 18 to 21 years of age in an R-3, Multi-Family Residential District, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) residents must be ages 18 through 21;
- 2) residents must be in school, employed, or both;
- 3) must be limited to the house on the North of the property;
- 4) the number of residents is limited to four; and
- 5) full compliance with all other municipal codes and ordinances.

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. If a permit/license has not been obtained on or
