Parking Ratio Variance to allow 171 on-site parking spaces for a multi-tenant commercial site with a proposed restaurant in a B-3, Community Business District; the Zoning Ordinance requires 219 on-site parking spaces for this site, with a restaurant, in a B-3, Community Business District.

Dear Applicant(s)/Property Owner(s):

On August 6, 2012, the Board of Zoning Adjustment approved your request for Parking Ratio Variance to allow 171 on-site parking spaces for a multi-tenant commercial site with a proposed restaurant in a B-3, Community Business District; the Zoning Ordinance requires 219 on-site parking spaces for this site, with a restaurant, in a B-3, Community Business District, at the above referenced location, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) coordination with Traffic Engineering regarding existing parking spaces which back into the right-of-way of Airport Boulevard, to possibly remove those spaces and/or create a controlled entrance near these spaces; and,
- 2) full compliance with municipal codes and ordinances.

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. If a permit/license has not been obtained on or before February 4, 2013, the **Parking Ratio Variance** will expire and become null and void. For additional assistance call (251) 208-5895.
