Access, Maneuvering and Surface Variances to allow a 16' wide entrance drive and 12' wide gate clearance, a 22' wide maneuvering area, and an aggregate-surface lay down yard in an I-1, Light Industry District; the Zoning Ordinance requires a minimum 24' wide entrance drive and gate clearance, a 24' wide maneuvering area, and requires a lay down yard to be surfaced with asphalt, concrete or an approved alternative paving surface in an I-1, Light Industry District.

Dear Applicant(s)/Property Owner(s):

On August 6, 2012, the Board of Zoning Adjustment approved your request for Access, Maneuvering and Surface Variances to allow a 16' wide entrance drive and 12' wide gate clearance, a 22' wide maneuvering area, and an aggregate-surface lay down yard in an I-1, Light Industry District; the Zoning Ordinance requires a minimum 24' wide entrance drive and gate clearance, a 24' wide maneuvering area, and requires a lay down yard to be surfaced with asphalt, concrete or an approved alternative paving surface in an I-1, Light Industry District, at the above referenced location, subject to the following condition:

1) full compliance with municipal codes and ordinances.

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. If a permit/license has not been obtained on or before February 4, 2013, the Access, Maneuvering and Surface Variances will expire and become null and void.
