On December 6, 2010, the Board of Zoning Adjustment approved a request for Sign Number, Sign Size, and Off Premise Sign Variances to allow a 100 square foot address sign, eight (8) tenant signs with a total of 1,554 square feet including one roof-mounted sign, and a 103.8 square foot off-premise advertising sign on a multi-tenant building in a B-4, General Business District and also in the Lower Dauphin Historic District was approved, subject to the following condition:

- 1) approval of the Architectural Review Board; and
- 2) full compliance with all municipal codes and ordinances.

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. If a permit/license has not been obtained on or
