Dear Applicant(s) / Property Owner(s):

On May 6, 2013, the Board of Zoning Adjustment approved your request for Tree Planting and Buffer Fence Variances to amend a previously approved Variance to allow no heritage tree plantings and no wooden privacy fence along a side property line adjoining residential use at an existing church youth annex in an R-1, Single-Family Residential District at the above referenced location, subject to the following conditions:

1) obtaining of a land disturbance permit to complete site improvements, including tree planting and paved parking, within 6 months of approval of the variance.

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. If a permit/license has not been obtained on or before November 6, 2013, the **Tree and Buffer Fence Variances** will expire and become null and void. For additional assistance call (251) 208-5895.
