On December 6, 2010, the Board of Zoning Adjustment approved a request for Side Yard Setback Variance to allow an accessory storage building (already constructed) within 4.5 feet of a side property line with a side yard sum of 16.9 feet in an R-1, Single Family Residential District was approved, subject to the following condition:

1) full compliance with all other codes and ordinances.

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. If a permit/license has not been obtained on or
