Dear Applicant/Property Owner:

On November 2, 2009 the Board of Zoning Adjustment approved your request for Use, Height, Side Yard Street Setback and Tree Planting Variances to allow the construction of a 153-foot monopole communications tower 112-feet from the side street property line and no tree plantings in an R-1, Single-Family Residential District; the Zoning Ordinance prohibits telecommunications towers in R-1, Single-Family Residential Districts, the maximum height allowed in R-1 Districts is 35' with a minimum 20' side yard street setback, and one tree per 30 linear feet of the leased parcel (with at least 50% of the number of trees to be overstory trees) is required for such a use at the above referenced location, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) limited to the one existing private collocation; and
- 2) full compliance with all other municipal codes and ordinances.

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. If a permit/license has not been obtained on or before May 3, 2010, the **Use, Height, Side Yard Street Setback and Tree Planting Variances** will expire and become null and void.
