Dear Applicant(s):

At its meeting on March 1, 2012, the Planning Commission waived Section V.D.3. of the Subdivision Regulations and approved the above referenced subdivision, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) **dedication to provide 30' from the centerline of Dykes Road North to Mobile County;**
- 2) **depiction of the 25-foot minimum building setback line from Dykes Road North, as required by Section V.D.9. of the Subdivision Regulations;**
- 3) **labeling of the lot sizes, in acres, or provision of a table on the Final Plat with the same information;**
- 4) **placement of a note on the Final Plat stating that any lots which are developed commercially and adjoin residentially developed property must provide a buffer, in compliance with Section V.A.8. of the Subdivision Regulations;**
- 5) **placement of a note on the Final Plat stating the site must comply with the City of Mobile stormwater and flood control ordinances: *"Must comply with the Mobile County Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance. Development shall be designed to comply with the stormwater detention and drainage facility requirements of the City of Mobile stormwater and flood control ordinances, and requiring submission of certification from a licensed engineer certifying that the design complies with the stormwater detention and drainage facility***

*requirements of the City of Mobile stormwater and flood control ordinances prior to the issuance of any permits;”*

- 6) placement of a note on the Final Plat limiting each lot to one curb-cut to Dykes Road North, with the size, design, and location of all curb-cuts to be approved by Mobile County Engineering and conform to AASHTO standards; and,**
- 7) placement of a note on the Final Plat stating that approval of all applicable federal, state, and local agencies is required for endangered, threatened, or otherwise protected species, if any, prior to the issuance of any permits or land disturbance activities.**

After you have obtained all the necessary approval signatures and the plat has been recorded in the Mobile County Probate Office, **seven** copies of the recorded plat (including map book and page number) must be submitted to the Land Use Administration office. This procedure must be completed within one (1) year, or the Tentative Approval will expire.

It is also requested that a digital copy (DXF or DWG – AutoCAD 2007 compatible) of the final plat be submitted to the Land Use Administration office once the plat has been submitted to Probate for recording.
