At its meeting on November 21, 2013, the Planning Commission considered your request for a change in zoning from I-1, Light-Industry District, to I-2, Heavy Industry District, to accommodate current and future businesses.

After discussion, it was decided to recommend this change in zoning to the City Council subject to the following conditions:

- 1. obtain after-the-fact land disturbance permits, building permits, and right-of-way permits;
- 2. compliance with all municipal codes and ordinances; and
- 3. compliance with the voluntary use restrictions as offered by the applicant at the meeting.

The advertising fee for this application is \$198.55. Upon receipt of this fee, your application will be forwarded to the City Clerk's office to be scheduled for public hearing by the City Council.
