(West side of U.S. Highway 90 West, 100'± South of I-10 Industrial Parkway, extending to the South side of I-10 Industrial Parkway, 300'± West of U.S. Highway 90 West).

Dear Applicant(s)/ Property Owner (s):

At its meeting on May 5, 2022, the Planning Commission considered the above referenced Subdivision application.

After discussion, the Planning Commission waived Section V.D.3. of the Subdivision Regulations and Tentatively Approved the request, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) dedication to provide 90 feet to the centerline of U.S. Highway 90 West, if necessary;
- 2) retention of the right-of-way for I-10 Industrial Parkway;
- 3) retention of the 25-foot minimum building setback line along both frontages, adjusted for dedication, if necessary;
- 4) retention of the lot size labels in both square feet and acres on the Final Plat, or the furnishing of a table on the Final Plat providing the same information, adjusted for dedication, if necessary;
- 5) compliance with the Engineering comments: (FINAL PLAT COMMENTS) (should be addressed prior to submitting the FINAL PLAT for review and/or signature by the City Engineer): A. Provide all of the required information on the SUBDIVISION PLAT (i.e., signature blocks, signatures, certification statements, written legal description, required notes, legend, scale, bearings, and distances) that is required by the current Alabama State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors. B. Check the FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION ORDINANCE NOTE. It references a Mobile County Ordinance. C. Add a note to the SUBDIVISION PLAT stating that as shown on the 1984 aerial photo (FLIGHT 20 #91) LOTS 1 and 2 will receive historical credit of existing (1984) impervious area towards stormwater detention requirement per Mobile City Code, Chapter 17, Storm Water Management and Flood Control) as follows: LOT 1 10,000 sf and LOT 2 2,000 sf. D. Email a pdf copy of the FINAL SUBDIVISION PLAT and LETTER OF DECISION to the Permitting Engineering Dept. for review at land.disturbance@cityofmobile.org prior to

obtaining any signatures. No signatures are required on the drawing. E. After addressing all of the FINAL SUBDIVISION PLAT review comments provide the ORIGINAL (with all signatures except for the Planning Commission, Traffic Engineering, and City Engineer), one (1) copy, and a transmittal letter to the Engineering Permitting Department. They can be dropped off at 205 Government St. or mailed to PO Box 1827, Mobile, AL, 36633.);

- 6) placement of a note on the Final Plat stating the Traffic Engineering comments: (Driveway number, size, location, and design to be approved by Traffic Engineering and conform to AASHTO standards. Any required on-site parking, including ADA handicap spaces, shall meet the minimum standards as defined in Section 64-6 of the City's Zoning Ordinance.);
- 7) compliance with the Urban Forestry comments: (Property to be developed in compliance with state and local laws that pertain to tree preservation and protection on both city and private properties [Act 929 of the 1961 Regular Session of the Alabama Legislature (Acts 1961, p. 1487), as amended, and City Code Chapters 57 and 65]. Private removal of trees in the right-of-way will require approval of the Mobile Tree Commission. Removal of heritage trees from undeveloped residential sites, developed residential sites in historic districts, and all commercial sites will require a tree removal permit.); and
- 8) compliance with the Fire-Rescue Department comments: (All projects within the City Limits of Mobile shall comply with the requirements of the City of Mobile Fire Code Ordinance (2012 International Fire Code). Fire apparatus access is required to be within 150' of all commercial and residential buildings. A fire hydrant is required to be within 400' of non-sprinkled commercial buildings and 600' of sprinkled commercial buildings.).

After you have obtained all the necessary approval signatures and the plat has been recorded in the Mobile County Probate Office, <u>five</u> copies of the recorded plat (including instrument number) must be submitted to the Planning and Zoning Department office. This procedure must be completed within one (1) year, or the Tentative Approval will expire.

Please also submit a CAD compatible (DXF) digital copy of the final plat to the Planning and Zoning Department office once the plat has been submitted to Probate for recording. This may be submitted on disk, flash drive, memory stick, or via e-mail to <a href="mailto:planning@cityofmobile.org">planning@cityofmobile.org</a>.
