## LETTER OF DECISION

## Re: 3235 Riverview Pointe Drive

(South side of Riverview Pointe Drive, 545'± West of Dog River Road, extending to the West side of Dog River Road, 190'± South of Riverview Pointe Drive). County

Dear Applicant(s)/ Property Owner(s):

At its meeting on August 16, 2018, the Planning Commission considered the above referenced subdivision application.

After discussion, the Planning Commission waived Sections V.D.1., V.D.3., and V.D.8. of the Subdivision Regulations and Tentatively Approved the request, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) retention of the minimum 60' rights-of-way along Riverview Pointe Drive and Dog River Road:
- 2) retention of the lot sizes in square feet and acres on the Final Plat, or provision of a table providing the same information;
- 3) retention of the 25' minimum building setback line along all street frontages;
- 4) placement of a note on the Final Plat stating Lot 1-A is limited to one (1) curb cut per frontage, and Lot 2-A is limited to one (1) curb cut to Riverview Pointe Drive, with any changes in their sizes, locations, or designs to be approved by Mobile County Engineering and conform to AASHTO standards;
- 5) placement of a note on the Final Plat stating that any lots which are developed commercially and adjoin residentially developed property must provide a buffer, in compliance with Section V.A.8. of the Subdivision Regulations; and

6) placement of a note on the Final Plat to comply with the Mobile County storm water and flood control ordinances: "Must comply with the Mobile County Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance. Development shall be designed to comply with the storm water detention and drainage facility requirements of the City of Mobile storm water and flood control ordinances, and requiring submission of certification from a licensed engineer certifying that the design complies with the storm water detention and drainage facility requirements of the City of Mobile storm water and flood control ordinances prior to the issuance of any permits."; and, compliance with Fire Department comments: "Projects outside the City Limits of Mobile, yet within the Planning Commission Jurisdiction fall under the State or County Fire Code (2012 IFC)."

After you have obtained all the necessary approval signatures and the plat has been recorded in the Mobile County Probate Office, <u>seven</u> copies of the recorded plat (including map book and page number) must be submitted to the Planning and Zoning Department office. This procedure must be completed within one (1) year, or the Tentative Approval will expire.

Please also submit a CAD compatible (DXF) digital copy of the final plat to the Planning and Zoning Department office once the plat has been submitted to Probate for recording. This may be submitted on disk, flash drive, memory stick, or via e-mail to <a href="mailto:planning@cityofmobile.org">planning@cityofmobile.org</a>.
