Dear Applicant(s) / Property Owner(s):

At its meeting on May 1, 2003, the Planning Commission approved the above referenced subdivision subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the placement of a note on the final plat stating that the site is denied direct access to the alley; and
- (2) the placement of the twenty-five foot minimum building setback line on the final plat.

After you have obtained all the necessary approval signatures and the plat has been recorded in the Mobile County Probate Office, **seven** copies of the recorded plat (including map book and page number) must be submitted to the Land Use Administration office. This procedure must be completed within one year, or the Tentative Approval will expire.

It is also requested that a digital copy of the final plat be submitted to the Land Use Administration office once the plat has been submitted to Probate for recording. This may be submitted on disk or via e-mail at [henley@cityofmobile.org](mailto:henley@cityofmobile.org).
