At its meeting on April 18, 2002, the Planning Commission considered your request for a change in zoning from B-1, Buffer Business, and R-1, Single-Family Residential, to B-1, Buffer Business, to eliminate split zoning at an existing child day care center.

After discussion it was decided to recommend the approval of this change in zoning to the City Council subject to the following conditions:

- 1) dedication of sufficient right-of-way along Garnett Avenue to provide 25' from centerline:
- 2) dedication of a 25'(minimum) radius at the intersection of Garnett Avenue and Spring Hill Avenue;
- 3) denial of access to Spring Hill Avenue;
- 4) completion of the Subdivision process prior to the issuance of any permits; and
- 5) full compliance with all municipal codes and ordinances, including but not limited to landscaping and tree planting requirements and provision of sidewalks.
