## BRANDY SUBDIVISION, RESUBDIVISION OF LOTS 2 & 3

<u>Engineering Comments:</u> Must comply with the Mobile County Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance.

The plat illustrates the proposed 3 lot,  $3.4 \pm$  acres subdivision which is located on the East side of Dawes Road,  $2/10 \text{ mile} \pm \text{South}$  of Leroy Stevens Road, extending to the West side of Leroy Stevens Road,  $2/10 \text{ mile} \pm \text{South}$  of Dawes Road. The subdivision is served by public water and individual septic systems.

The purpose of this application is to resubdivide two lots into three.


As indicated on the Vicinity Map, Lot C fronts both Dawes Road and Leroy Stevens Road. Therefore, as a means of access management, a note should be placed on the final plat stating that Lot C is limited to one curb cut for only one street (Leroy Stevens Road) to avoid potential cut through traffic.

This site is located in the County, thus a note should be placed on the final plat stating that any lots which are developed commercially and adjoin residentially developed property must provide a buffer, in compliance with Section V.A.7. of the Subdivision Regulations.

The 25-foot minimum building setback lines are not shown but would be required on the final plat.

The plat meets the minimum requirements of the Subdivision Regulations and is recommended for Tentative Approval subject to the following conditions: 1) the placement of a note on the final plat stating that Lot C is limited to one curb cut for only one street (Leroy Stevens Road); 2) the placement of a note on the final plat stating that any property that is developed commercially and adjoins residentially developed property shall provide a buffer, in compliance with Section V.A.7. of the Subdivision Regulations; and 3) the placement of the 25-foot minimum setback lines on the final plat.
